If you are, this year's Ground to Sound program is for you!

Campers entering 5th - 7th grade conduct field studies, while exploring the woods, waters and trails at the Brightwater Environmental Center. They'll work in a team to learn how saving Puget Sound starts in our own backyard!

The week long, full day camp immerses young people in intensive field and lab work, combining creativity and art with sophisticated technology and lab equipment. The camp includes innovative challenges that generate tremendous excitement for environmental stewardship. Campers will master Science, Technology, Engineering and Math concepts and processes and communicate their growing knowledge in iMovies.

The GTS camp experience is equivalent to a full semester of middle school science, in a setting that is fantastic fun for everyone.

Campers are supported with three levels of leadership: one mentor for each group of 5, two high school interns and six award winning certified science teacher-naturalists with many years of experience.
